PLANS FOR THE NEW CHURCH BUILDING

While the new building will not include a bell tower or other overtly church – like qualities on the exterior, it will:

- look like a church inside.
- be used exclusively as a church until the permanent church can be built.
- be designed in such a way that the exterior can serve both current and future needs.
- be used as parish hall or dormitory once the the permanent church is able to be built.

The new church building will include the following:

- our current gym altar
- pews with capacity of 300 – 400
- a choir loft
- all other needs of a church:
  - baptistry
  - sacristy
  - side altars
  - confessional (s)
- restrooms and vestibule
- small gathering area and cry room, if possible

Renderings of the exterior and interior designs are in process and will be shared as they develop from initial drafts to completed designs. Stay tuned!
