- Friday, April 18th— to Fast (ages 18 –59) and Abstain from meat (ages 14+)
- All Fridays in Lent — to Abstain from meat (ages 14+)
- All of Lent — to be observed as a time of penance
- During Easter Time — to receive Holy Communion {1st Sunday of Lent (3/9/25) — Trinity Sunday (6/15/25)}
