On the other days, it is true, the faithful are not bound to hear Mass, but our holy Mother the Church earnestly wishes that all her children should and would assist at this salutary Sacrifice as often as possible. In most churches, Mass is said every day; in some, several times a day; and where ever it is offered, the people are invited to assist.
