UPDATES

Church: Over the summer, and ending before September, the new electrical and replacement of the old electrical will be installed. Between Draperies Inc. and our pavement to the parking lot on the grass, a transformer will be installed. The pavement will need to be cut to run the piping.

SILENCE IN CHAPEL

How can we show our respect for Our Lord & for those praying? By meditating in silence. Please reflect on the noise we make, or our movements, e.g. leaving the chapel unless it's a necessity, which are distractions.

If your children are keeping you and those around you from praying, perhaps you can devise a plan to keep them home or remove them quickly if they become vocally fussy. It is difficult to teach young children how to behave in Mass, and we all accept the cross and pray for parents.

We will, when possible, have a weekly Mass (Wed. at 8:15 am beginning on July 15th by Fr. Boyle) designated for mothers to bring their younger children where more understanding is present. Be sure to check the bulletin for the time and day if applicable.
