- Easter Duty: Holy Communion between 1st Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday (assuming a good confession beforehand)
- Please remember Friday abstinence binds more gravely during Lent
- Prayer Resolutions for Lent (accomplish an item in each of the 3 categories)
 - Prayer
 - visit the Blessed Sacrament/Spiritual Communion
 - visit the cemetery
 - Schedule your retreat
 - Sanctify Sunday with spiritual works
 - Fasting (sacrifice)
 - purge house or family of worldly reading, modern influences and media: e.g. Harry Potter, Pokémon, Disney, & anime
 - unplug from technology (to some extent or completely)
 - Alms
 - donate to the Church Building Fund (a large container is available in the chapel hallway for easy donations)
