



INTRODUCTION

Cemetery regulations play a most important part in the beautification and preservation of the sacred resting place of the faithful departed. They are intended not as restraining, but rather as defining an orderly plan of operation, care and permanent maintenance.

All plots and graves in the cemetery are subject to these regulations (as well as any amendments or changes which may be adopted). All plot holders and visitors are requested to respect the provisions contained here and in the SSPX - Blessed Virgin Mary Church Cemetery Interment Rights Purchase Agreement.

GRAVES & PLOTS

All internments require the written approval of the Pastor or his delegate and are subject to the rules and regulations of the Roman Catholic Church (Canon Law) and all applicable state and local laws (as referenced in the Purchase Agreement).

While the Cemetery is officially “closed” during the winter, internments may be allowed as per NYS laws, provided that snow, ice or frozen grounds do not prohibit entry and access.



MONUMENTS & MARKERS

Monuments must be made of granite or natural stone. No wood or composite materials of any kind are allowed for permanent markers or monuments.

Monuments or markers must be placed on a substantial concrete foundation.

Height and style of monuments or markers may be limited and must be approved by Pastor.

Only one central or family monument may be placed on a plot. Smaller markers are permitted on individual graves.

FLOWERS, PLANTS, SHRUBS, BOUQUETS

The Cemetery is maintained by BVM Church which is responsible for grass mowing and trimming. To ensure ease of maintenance and mowing, as well as for the aesthetics of the property, the Cemetery must enforce the following rules. The Cemetery reserves the right to remove items (flowers, containers, etc.) that become unsightly or when they do not conform to the standards listed herein.

PERMITTED

- Bouquets (maximum of 5 at any one time)
- Two potted plants or urns per grave
- Artificial flowers (only in winter)
- Flags (for national holidays, provided suitably maintained and well respected)
- Wreaths

NOT PERMITTED

- Planted shrubs or flowers
- Hanging baskets or flower boxes
- Glass jars, bottles, crockery
- Styrofoam or papier-mâché
- Vigil lights
- Mowing or grading or planting
- Gravel or mulch
- Artificial flowers (within the growing season)
