Dear Faithful,

According to St. Francis de Sales in his <u>Introduction to the Devout Life</u> speaking on the the "7th truth" of the interior life, which refers to the development of one's spiritual life, he says: "A true increase in virtue is achieved through a consistent and dedicated practice of small, everyday acts of goodness, rather than grand gestures or occasional acts of piety. Essentially, focusing on cultivating 'little virtues' in daily life leads to a deeper and more authentic spiritual growth." As we thank God for the past 25 years of daily sacraments, let us strive to be faithful to what we have received. To this end, anticipate more graces in the future, having a more vibrant parish life in the next 25 years, by following this advice and be *committed* to increasing our virtue — day by day!
